- The DAIP shall have the power to assess the level of plagiarism and recommend penalty(ies) accordingly.
- The DAIP after investigation shall submit its report with the recommendation on penalties to be imposed the IAIP within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of complaint/initiation of the proceedings.
